

Dogs may be used for hunting in Northern Territory Hunting Reserves. You must obtain a permit from the Parks and Wildlife Commissionfirst and keep all dogs on a leash

The four designated hunting reserves are:

- Harrison Dam
- Howard Springs Hunting Reserve
- Shoal Bay Coastal Reserve.

Before you visit Northern Territory Parks and Reserves, check with the local Parks and Wildlife office. Be sure of the conditions relating to pets in the Parks you are visiting.

Registration

All dogs over 3 months that have been in Darwin for 1 month must be registered and microchipped

Dogs In The Tropics

Make sure you acclimate your pet to your new climate gradually. Take your dog for walks in the day and evening to get him used to all temperature extremes, starting with shorter walks and steadily getting longer. Groom your pet's coat to suit the climate. Longhaired dogs should get a trim for warmer weather, and especially for warm humid weather, where a long coat can actually develop a moldy

smell. Keep the water up and available 24/7, take them for a swim or put them under a

sprinkler (A small child's pool is great in the yard for dogs). **NEVER KEEP DOGS IN THE CAR**

WITHOUT THE AIRCON ON

Cane Toad Poisoning Hold your pets mouth down toward the floor

and using paper towel wipe the inside of their mouth. Thoroughly wash the mouth out for 10-15 minutes using a slow trickling hose or tap, have water flowing from the side of the back teeth with the water draining out through the front of the mouth, avoid water going down the throat or into the lungs. Using a wet cloth, gently wipe the gums, tongue and roof of the mouth, rinse the cloth out after each wipe and do for 10 minutes. If your pet settles down after wiping and rinsing the mouth out, keep them confined for a few hours and monitor them closely, transport to a vet immediately (if symptoms worsen)
